- **Free and Reduced Applications:** This year you will notice we have new free and reduced applications. These are family applications and color coded with a Spanish version on the back. The cafeteria manager at each school will prescreen the applications to make sure they have all needed information to be processed before sending to the Child Nutrition Office. We will process as quickly as possible and notify parents.
- Kindergarten students **will not receive free breakfast this school year.** This was a state program and as part of the budget process, the state has ended the funds for free kindergarten breakfast.
- For the first ten days of school all students will eat according to their **last years lunch status.** For example: if they paid last year they will pay this year, if they ate reduce last year then they will eat reduce this year, if they were free this year. Again this is only for the first ten days to allow students to submit a new application for this year. If students wish to be considered for free and reduce lunch they must submit a new lunch application.
